

Bubbles



A colourful game of quick observation and reaction by Wolfgang Dirscherl
for 2 - 4 players from 6 years upwards

Red, yellow, blue and green: These are the colours of the many shiny, colourful bubbles that are displayed in different sizes on the cards. It can be quite challenging to keep an overview, how quickly can you spot the card with the same combination of bubbles indicated by the dice? With a little concentration and quick reactions you will master the challenge!

Contents:

4 dice in the colours red, yellow, blue and green • Stickers for the dice in the colours red, yellow, blue and green • 24 cards • 1 rule

Aim of the game:

Everyone tries to be the quickest to spot the correct card showing the bubbles in the same sequence as the dice.

Game Preparation:

- Before the first game you have to apply the stickers to the dice.
All red stickers go on the red dice; all green stickers go on the green dice etc.
- Agree on the game variant:

For the easy variant use the card sides with the orange frame. All the bubbles on these cards are sorted in sequence from largest to smallest.

For the difficult variant you need to use the card sides with the grey frame. The bubbles on these cards are not in any order whatsoever making it much harder to spot the correct card!

Tip: You can combine both variants in the same game by using some of the cards with the orange frame and some cards with the grey frame. This is because all cards display the same combination of bubbles on either side.



- Once you have agreed on a variant place the 24 cards with the chosen frame colours face up in the middle of the table. Make sure the cards are not on top of each other and have the dice ready for play.

Game play:

- Everyone plays at the same time. The eldest player throws the dice and the search for the correct card begins.
- Each dice shows a number between 1 and 24. You must all try to find the card that correctly matches the result on the dice as quickly as possible: This means you need to first have a look at the sequence of the colours on the dice. The largest number on the dice is the largest bubble on the cards; the second highest number is the second largest bubble on the cards etc.
- If you think you have found the right card with the matching combination then place your hand on that card. Be careful: if you have decided on a card you can't change your mind afterwards! As soon as all players have chosen a card or think another player has found the correct card ahead of them we perform a check: The player who has his hand on the correct card gets to keep that card as a reward and must place it in front of himself.

Example:



The red dice shows „20“ as the highest number = largest bubble

The green dice shows “19” as the second highest number = second largest bubble etc.

Important: Cards that have been collected remain in play as the combination on that card may come up again during play. It is therefore quite possible to lose a card to another player as the game progresses. Collected cards therefore have to be placed so that they are still visible and accessible to other players

- Then it is the next player's turn to throw the dice and a new round begins.

End of game:

The game is concluded as soon as a player has a total of 4 cards placed in front of himself.
